1. If you would like to order a large quality of seed potatoes this autumn your order needs to be with **Anna on 07765 923106** or by email at feldmanfamily@mail.com **by the 15 October 2019** or tell someone in the shop.

We will not hold any 25kg sacks in stock so you need to pre-order these NOW.

Ask friends, uncles, grannies or anyone who may want them and get their order to Anna. We will have plenty of 2kg bags in stock which do not need pre-ordering.

2. We have recently had some issues with **polytunnels**, particularly with them blowing away with the possibility of them blowing onto the Hendon Way.
